This month's message "The Fifth Season" speaks of the woman of Canaan that came to Jesus asking Him to heal her daughter. Therefore, we do not have to wait for things to happen or seasons to be fulfilled, but we must understand the rules that govern Kingdom season in order to activate it. There was a time when rain didn't fall for three years; it did not mean the rain or the clouds was not there but it took a man of God who knew how to pray and shake the heavens till the rain came. You can activate the principle that govern Kingdom season to receive from God what is rightly yours. May this word bless you and encourage you to reach out to God for yourself.

His coming is closer than you think! For the month of November we discussed the signs of His return and how to get ourselves ready. St. Matthew 24 speaks about signs of wars, kingdom against kingdom, nation against nation, famines, pestilence and earthquakes that these are the beginning of sorrow. When we look around us today these are visible signs and what we are instructed of the Lord to do is 'look up'. We cannot look to the East or the West, nor can we look to man for an answer.
